

Afternoon Activities- 'Dinosaurs and Princesses'

Please complete one of these activities for your home learning each afternoon and share what you have done with your teachers on Tapestry.

RE	Set up and carry out your own Prayer Service at home with your family. What could it be about? What could you pray for?	Create a 'Lent' sign to help you to remember the season we are in. Use as much purple as you can!	
Literacy	Listen to the story of Cinderella and make an invitation to ball.	Research some dinosaur names and see if you can learn to spell your favourite ones. There are some tricky ones out there!	Listen to your favourite story about a princess/prince or a dinosaur and see if you can retell the story. You might want to write it down, draw some pictures or act it out!
Maths	Play this game to help you practice ordering numbers to 10.	Go on a number walk looking for the numbers 6, 7 and 8. See how many times you can find them.	

<h3>Understanding the World</h3>	<p>Choose your favourite dinosaur and do some research on it. What can you find out about it? Share your facts with us!</p> 	<p>Do some research on our Queen and see what facts you can learn about her. Where does she live? What does she look like? Share your facts with us!</p> 	<p>Have a look at some different castles around the world. Make a picture of one and see if you can label some of the different parts.</p>
<h3>Expressive Art and Design</h3>	<p>Design a crown or an outfit for a prince or a princess. Have a think about what colours you might use and when they might wear these.</p> 	<p>Use these instructions to make your own fossil.</p> 	<p>Design and make your own magic wand. You could use this idea or do whatever you like. Think about how you can make it really special!</p> 
<h3>Communication and Language</h3>	<p>Think of a dinosaur and describe it to a friend or someone in your family. They have to guess which dinosaur you are! Remember to use adjectives to describe the dinosaur. For example, "I am big. I have a long neck and a long tail. I like to eat the leaves in the trees." You could use an information book to help you find out what they look like.</p>
