



## Learning Project WEEK 8 – Superworm

Weekly RE Tasks (Aim to do 1 or 2 per week)	Weekly Literacy Tasks (Aim to do 1 or 2 per week)
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Revise making the sign of the cross. Name the days of the week and discuss what you do on different days. Talk to the children about Sunday being a special day of the week when we rest (recapping the Creation story).</li> <li>Sit quietly together and ask your child to blow onto their hands, both gently and strongly. Ask your child what they can feel? Explain that we can feel air but we cannot see it. One person chooses some body percussion (for example patting their knees or clapping their hands) and the rest of the family have to copy them. Take turns being the leader.</li> </ul> <p><i>Reception:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Please check Tapestry daily for your child's phonics tasks.</li> </ul>

## Learning Project - to be done throughout the week

The project this week aims to provide opportunities for your child to gain a better understanding of the story 'Superworm'.

- **Expressive Arts and Design (Music)**

Compose a tune to accompany the 'Superworm' chant that appears throughout the story.

Sing the 'I Love Worms' rhyme.

- **Expressive Arts and Design (Art)**

Design a superhero costume for Superworm to wear.

Cook some spaghetti and pull it through paint to make your own worms.

Use an old sock to make your own Superworm.

- **Physical Development (Gross Motor Skills)**

Practise skipping outside either with or without a skipping rope. If you have a skipping rope, see how many you can do in a row.

- **Communication and Language**

Go through this 'Where is the worm?' activity and practise your positional language.
