<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Set up a Prayer Service with your family. You may wish to use this <a href="#">website</a> to support your prayer; light a candle to remind you that God always shines His light.</li> <li>Discuss the way you choose your friends. What is special about your friends? What do you enjoy doing with your friends? How does this make you feel? ## Learning Project - to be done throughout the week

The project this week aims to provide opportunities for your child to gain a better understanding of the story 'The Princess and the Wizard'.

- **Expressive Arts and Design (Music)**

Make an instrument that makes a twinkly sound that could be used for a wand. You could use something metal or even bells. Listen to the story again and use your instrument to put in sound effects whenever the wizard uses magic.

- **Expressive Arts and Design (Art)**

Design a new sparkly outfit for the Princess or the wizard to wear.

Draw all of the things in the story using the correct colours.

Design and make your own castle for Princess Eliza to live in. You could even make a Princess and a wizard for the castle.

- **Physical Development (Gross Motor Skills)**

Using your cutting skills make a new hat for the wizard or crown for the Princess.

- **Communication and Language**

How many types of Princesses can you think of? Look at google images of Princess Kate and discuss the difference between a fictional Princess and a real life Royal Princess.

- **Understanding the World**

Make your own bubbling potions.
