

Learning Project WEEK 13– Towers, Tunnels and Turrets

Age Range: Year 2

Weekly RE Tasks (Aim to do one per day)

This week you will be looking at Bible stories and their meanings. Read each of the stories in your Bible.

- Draw and label a picture of Noah and the Ark (Genesis 6: 9-22) and next to your picture write down the meaning of the story.
- Create a story map of Abraham and Isaac (Genesis 22: 1-14) and underneath your story map write down the meaning of the story.
- Read the story of David and Goliath (1 Samuel 17) and think about the meaning of the story.
- Read The story of Daniel (Daniel 6:10) and think about the meaning of the story.
- Now think about your favourite story and why you like it.

Choose one of your pieces of work for RE this week and upload it to Class Dojo.

Weekly Reading Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)

- Ask your child to read a chapter from their home reading book or a book that they have borrowed from the library.
- Complete a task from their reading journal.
- Complete the <u>reading</u> lesson.
- Read the books I have set on Go Epic!

Weekly Maths Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)

- Working on <u>Times Table Rockstars</u>. If your child works on <u>Numbots</u> in school they can access this with the same login.
- Play on <u>Hit the Button</u> number bonds, halves, doubles and times tables.
- Play the mental maths train game about using the four operation.
