

Learning Project WEEK 8– Towers, Tunnels and Turrets

Year 2

Weekly RE Tasks (Aim to do one per day)

- Talk to your child about our community.
 Think about all the different communities they are a part of- family. Church, school etc.
- What makes each of these a community?
 Draw one of the communities and write 2 sentences about it.
- What responsibilities and roles to the different people in each of the communities have? Why are these roles needed?
- Think about and draw the different responsibilities in the parish. Such as the priest, the alter servers, readers etc.
- Think about why the church is an important building in the parish community. Create a mind map of things that happen in the church building.

Weekly Reading Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)

- Ask your child to read a chapter from their home reading book or a book that they have borrowed from the library.
- Complete a task from their reading journal.
- Listen to a story read: https://www.storylineonline.net/
- Read chapters 2 and 3 of the <u>'The</u> <u>Worst Zoo in the World'</u> and answer the questions that follow.

Weekly Maths Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)

- Working on <u>Times Table Rockstars</u>. If your child works on <u>Numbots</u> in school they can access this with the same login.
- Play on <u>Hit the Button</u> number bonds, halves, doubles and times tables.
- Play the mental maths train game about using the four operation.
- Complete the <u>addition and subtraction</u> activity online.
- We will now be using 'Oak Academy' online lessons which provide lessons and activities which can be completed online. Please click on the link and complete the first 5 lessons, one each day.

Weekly Writing Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)

- Watch your favourite film or a film you haven't watched before. Create a story map for the film.
- Write a setting description for a scene in the film remembering to use your five senses and lots of adjectives.
- How could you change the end of the film? Think of a new ending for the film and write it down. Try to include lots of detail.
- Re-tell the story of the film with your new ending. Remember to use different sentence starters and some super adjectives.
- Edit and improve your new story. Check your spellings and punctuation carefully.

Learning Project - to be done throughout the week

The project this week aims to provide opportunities for your child to gain a better understanding of medieval times.

Design Technology

Design and make a crown for a king or a queen. Think about what materials you are going to use and how you are going to join them.

Science

Use the link to make an insect out of natural materials.

Geography

Use observational skills to look at the geography of your home and the surrounding area. Try to create a map that show your home and the natural and man-made features around it- hills, rivers, forest, canal, factories, farm, office, shops, etc.
