Weekly RE Tasks (Aim to do one per day)	Weekly Reading Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Read this week's reading in your homework diary. What is the message? How is it relevant to us today? Write a prayer service for your family. Watch Faith at Home Read the Road to Damascus Story Acts 9: 1-19 or watch Paul's Ministry. Draw two pictures of Paul, one at the start of the story and one at the end. Label them both to describe what he was like. (Class Dojo) Write a letter as if you are Paul describe how you have changed and why. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Ask your child to read a chapter from their home reading book or a book that they have borrowed from the library. Listen to your child read and let them discuss what they have read. Encourage them to read with expression and intonation. Read a book from Epic. Try something different to what you would normally read. Complete an activity in your reading journal as soon as you've finished reading a book. (Class Dojo) Use this lesson to revise the meaning of questions in comprehension activities.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Working on Times Table Rockstars your child will have an individual login to access this (20 mins on Garage). Play on Hit the Button - focus on number bonds, halves, doubles and times tables Play Solvemoji. How high up the leaderboard can you get? Have a look at this imoves video to help practise your times tables. (Class Dojo) Complete a fractions lesson on BBCbitesize. Identify 2D shapes with Oak National Academy lessons. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Continue your journal. What has changed in your life or the country or the world over the last week? Practise your spellings with this washing line game. If you haven't got a printer – what other letters could you use? Cut out of magazines? Scrabble or Banagrams tiles? Use this BBC Bitesize activity to help you write your own nonsense poem. (Class Dojo) Investigate sound words. Write about your favourite memory. When did it happen? Who was there?
