Weekly RE Tasks (Aim to do one per day)	Weekly Reading Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Read this week's reading in your homework diary. What is the message? How is it relevant to us today? • Write a prayer service for your family. • Watch Faith at Home • Watch 'The Thankful Leper' or read Luke 17: 11-19 • Create a mind map about how you think Jesus would have felt about the lepers who came to him. (Class Dojo) • What does this miracle tell us about the importance of being thankful? 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ask your child to read a chapter from their home reading book or a book that they have borrowed from the library. • Read a book from Epic. Try something different to what you would normally read. • Complete an activity in your reading journal as soon as you've finished reading a book. • Record yourself reading a section from your favourite story. Remember to read with expression and intonation. (Class Dojo) • Use this comprehension lesson to find out word meanings. • Listen to the audiobook 'The Bolds'.

What has changed in your life or the country or the world over the last week? • Play Spelling tiles to help practise spellings or choose 5 words from the Year 3 and 4 common exception words and write them in pyramid writing. • Plan and write a biography of someone you think deserves a statue to celebrate their achievements. Begin by researching their life. Where/when were they born? What was their childhood like? What was their adulthood like? What have they achieved? Why should they be remembered? • Write a monster poem using these resources to help. (Class Dojo) • Write a recipe for a potion inspired by 'George's Marvelous Medicine'.

Learning Project - to be done throughout the week

Some of these tasks will be set via 'Class Dojo' during the week – please complete them online, as teachers will be able to provide feedback.

- **Music –** Find out [why singing makes us feel good and](#) learn to sing like an opera singer.
- **Art –** Make a sculpture/statue of somebody who you think deserves one for their achievements but does not have one. What material will you use? Clay, playdough, plasticine? What size will your statue be? How will you shape/mould your statue? (Class Dojo)
- **Design Technology –** design an award (eg a medal or trophy) to give to someone in the class for doing well in Year 3.
- **Science –** Set up your own [example of the water cycle](#) using a sandwich bag. If you don't have any food colouring, you could use coloured drinks.
- **History –** Think about your time in Year 3. What are your favourite memories? Use the worksheet on Class Dojo to help you.
- **Geography –** We've had lots of different weather lately. Find out why [here](#).
