


Learning Project WEEK 14

Weekly RE Tasks (Aim to do one per day)	Weekly Reading Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)
 Read this week's reading in your homework diary. What is the message? How is it relevant to us today? Write a prayer service for your family. Watch Faith at Home Watch '<u>The Thankful Leper'</u> or read Luke 17: 11-19 Create a mind map about how you think Jesus would have felt about the lepers who came to him. (Class Dojo) What does this miracle tell us about the importance of being thankful? 	 Ask your child to read a chapter from their home reading book or a book that they have borrowed from the library. Read a book from <u>Epic</u>. Try something different to what you would normally read. Complete an activity in your reading journal as soon as you've finished reading a book. Record yourself reading a section from your favourite story. Remember to read with expression and intonation. (Class Dojo) Use this comprehension <u>lesson</u> to find out word meanings. Listen to the audiobook '<u>The Bolds</u>'.
