

Learning Project WEEK 3 – Plants		
Age Range: Year 3		
Weekly RE Tasks (Aim to do one per day)	Weekly Reading Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)	
 Read this week's reading in your homework diary. What is the message? How is it relevant to us today? Write and carry out a prayer service for your family. What do you need to include? In class we looked at how we can be more like Jesus by helping those in need. Find out what CAFOD do and how we can support them. Watch this Lego video about Lent. Which activities mentioned did you do? Is there anything you might do differently next year? Test your knowledge of Lent with this crossword. 	 Ask your child to read a chapter from their home reading book or a book that they have borrowed from the library. Listen to your child read and let them discuss what they have read. Encourage them to read with expression and intonation. Read text other than books e.g., a recipe, news article, instructions. Discuss what is their purpose. How are they different to a non-fiction book? Explore new vocabulary you find when reading. What are the origins of this word? Can it be modified? Can you find any synonyms or antonyms for your new word? Complete an activity in your reading journal as soon as you've finished reading a book. With your child, look in magazines, newspapers and books for new vocabulary they are unfamiliar with. They could use a highlighter to highlight in magazines and newspapers 	

Weekly Maths Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)	Weekly Writing Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)
 Working on <u>Times Table Rockstars</u>. Your child will have an individual login to access this. Test yourself on Studio. Adding totals of the weekly shopping list or some work around money. This <u>game</u> could support work on adding money. Play on <u>Hit the Button</u> - focus on number bonds, halves, doubles and times tables Keep practising the 8 times table. Use this <u>song</u> to help you. Practise counting forwards and backwards from any given number in 100s. Play <u>Solvemoji</u>, Can you move up a level? Practise telling the time. This could be done through this <u>game</u> (scroll down to access the game). Read to the quarter hour and the nearest 5 minutes. 	 Write a poem about staying at home. Write a short story together by playing Consequences. Find out how here. Write a review of a book you have read or a film you have watched over Easter. Continue your journal. How did you celebrate Easter this year? How was it different to normal? Download and complete spelling activities for this week at twinkl or practise spellings on ICT games – year 3/4 words Write a recipe for your favourite meal.

Learning Project - to be done throughout the week

The project this week aims to provide opportunities for your child to gain a better understanding of plants.

- Music Listen to the song about parts of the plant. Do you recognise the tune?
- Art Sketch a plant in your house or garden. Add as much detail as possible.
- <u>Design Technology</u> design a greenhouse using recycled packaging. <u>Here</u> are a few ideas to help you.
- <u>Science-</u> grow your own seeds on the window using this <u>activity</u>. You could use any fruit seeds eg apple pips, pepper seeds, beans,
- History find out how plants have been used in history as medicine.
- Geography research what a biome is. What biomes are found in Europe?
- **<u>PHSE</u>** Draw a plant and on each leaf draw or write about something that you love. Include people and activities.
- Watch Newsround and discuss what is happening in the wider world.
