



## Learning Project WEEK 3 –

### Plants

Age Range: Year 3

#### Weekly RE Tasks (Aim to do one per day)

- Read this week's reading in your homework diary. What is the message? How is it relevant to us today?
- Write and carry out a prayer service for your family. What do you need to include?
- In class we looked at how we can be more like Jesus by helping those in need. Find out what CAFOD do and how we can support them.
- Watch this [Lego video](#) about Lent. Which activities mentioned did you do? Is there anything you might do differently next year?
- Test your knowledge of Lent with this [crossword](#).

#### Weekly Reading Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)

- Ask your child to read a chapter from their home reading book or a book that they have borrowed from the library.
- Listen to your child read and let them discuss what they have read. Encourage them to read with expression and intonation.
- Read text other than books e.g., a recipe, news article, instructions. Discuss what is their purpose. How are they different to a non-fiction book?
- Explore new vocabulary you find when reading. What are the origins of this word? Can it be modified? Can you find any synonyms or antonyms for your new word?
- Complete an activity in your reading journal as soon as you've finished reading a book.
- With your child, look in magazines, newspapers and books for new vocabulary they are unfamiliar with. They could use a highlighter to highlight in magazines and newspapers

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Working on <a href="#">Times Table Rockstars</a>. Your child will have an individual login to access this. Test yourself on Studio.</li> <li>● Adding totals of the weekly shopping list or some work around money. This <a href="#">game</a> could support work on adding money.</li> <li>● Play on <a href="#">Hit the Button</a> - focus on number bonds, halves, doubles and times tables</li> <li>● Keep practising the 8 times table. Use this <a href="#">song</a> to help you.</li> <li>● Practise counting forwards and backwards from any given number in 100s.</li> <li>● Play <a href="#">Solvemoji</a>. Can you move up a level?</li> <li>● Practise telling the time. This could be done through this <a href="#">game</a> (scroll down to access the game). ## Learning Project - to be done throughout the week

The project this week aims to provide opportunities for your child to gain a better understanding of plants.

- **Music** – Listen to the song about parts of the plant. Do you recognise the tune?
- **Art** – Sketch a plant in your house or garden. Add as much detail as possible.
- **Design Technology** – design a greenhouse using recycled packaging. [Here](#) are a few ideas to help you.
- **Science**– grow your own seeds on the window using this [activity](#). You could use any fruit seeds eg apple pips, pepper seeds, beans,
- **History** – find out how plants have been used in history as medicine.
- **Geography** – research what a biome is. What biomes are found in Europe?
- **PHSE** – Draw a plant and on each leaf draw or write about something that you love. Include people and activities.
- Watch Newsround and discuss what is happening in the wider world.
