

Learning Project WEEK 6 – Plants

Age Range: Year 3

Weekly RE Tasks (Aim to do one per day)

Read this week's reading in your homework diary. What is the message? How is it relevant to us today?

- Write and carry out a prayer service for your family. What do you need to include?
- Read the Road to Emmaus story Luke 24:1-35. What phrases show us that the disciples did not recognise Jesus? How did Jesus make himself known to them?
- Imagine that you are one of the disciples. Write a diary entry of the Road to Emmaus story. How do your feeling change throughout the story?
- Go on an Emmaus Walk. Can you act out the story as you are walking?

Weekly Reading Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)

- Ask your child to read a chapter from their home reading book or a book that they have borrowed from the library.
- Listen to your child read and let them discuss what they have read.
 Encourage them to read with expression and intonation.
- Watch Newsround and discuss what is happening in the wider world.
- Read the instructions to a board game.
 Can you explain to someone else how to play it?
- Use YouTube for karaoke. Try to use songs that you do not know all the lyrics to so that you are reading the words.
- Complete an activity in your reading journal as soon as you've finished reading a book.
- Complete the <u>Worst Witch</u> lesson on BBC Bitesize

Weekly Maths Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)

- Working on <u>Times Table Rockstars</u> your child will have an individual login to access this (20 mins on Garage).
- Play on <u>Hit the Button</u> focus on number bonds, halves, doubles and times tables
- Play <u>Solvemoji</u>. How high up the leaderboard can you get?
- Keep practising the 8 times table.
 Use this <u>song</u> to help you. Can you complete these times table <u>games</u>?
- Have a go at these maths <u>challenges</u>. Write your own maths challenges using fractions.
- Comparing <u>fractions</u> lesson from Oaks Academy.

Weekly Writing Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)

- Continue your journal. Did you celebrate the VE day anniversary? What did your family do?
- Download and complete spelling activities for this week at <u>twinkl</u> or practise spellings on <u>ICT games</u> – year 3/4 words
- Write a sound poem using this <u>lesson</u> to help. What noises can you here inside your house? What words can you use to describe them? Is your poem going to rhyme?
- Write a letter to someone in your class telling them what you have been up to and what you are looking forward to when you see them again.
- Imagine that you can become invisible whenever you wanted to.
 What are some of the things you would do? Write a list.
- Use this plant <u>poem</u> to practise your handwriting.

Learning Project - to be done throughout the week

The project this week aims to provide opportunities for your child to gain a better understanding of plants.

- Music have a look at this song about what plants need to survive.
- <u>Art –</u> find out which artists are famous for painting flowers. What are their paintings called? When were they painted? Where are they now?
- <u>Design Technology</u> design a garden for a hospital to give hope to staff and patients.

- **History** read about famous trees in history
- **Geography** look at food packaging to find out where it has come from. Can you locate it on a map? What has travelled the furthest?
- <u>PHSE Look</u> at the Cough, Splutter, Sneeze <u>PowerPoint</u> and discuss_the importance of cleanliness and the spread of germs and disease.
