

Learning Project WEEK 7 – Plants	
Age Range: Year 3	
Weekly RE Tasks (Aim to do one per day)	Weekly Reading Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)
 Read this week's reading in your homework diary. What is the message? How is it relevant to us today? Write a prayer service for your family. Watch Faith at Home – Hope. Complete an activity for 'Maisy Milk'. Pray a decade a day for the week. Read John 21:1-14: Breakfast by the Sea of Galilee. Which words show that the disciples do not recognise Jesus? Which words and phrases tell us how Jesus made himself known? Draw pictures of Simon Peter and the disciples. Create captions to show their thoughts and feelings about meeting Jesus again after the resurrection. 	 Ask your child to read a chapter from their home reading book or a book that they have borrowed from the library. Listen to your child read and let them discuss what they have read. Encourage them to read with expression and intonation. Watch Newsround and discuss what is happening in the wider world. Read the instructions to a board game. Can you explain to someone else how to play it? Watch a TV program or a film with the subtitles and no sound. Complete an activity in your reading journal as soon as you've finished reading a book. Complete the Stone Age Cook Book comprehension on Classroom Secrets Kids
 Weekly Maths Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day) Working on <u>Times Table Rockstars</u> your child will have an individual login to access this (20 mins on Studio). Play on <u>Hit the Button</u> - focus on number bonds, halves, doubles and times tables Play <u>Solvemoji</u>, How high up the leaderboard can you get? Keep practising the 8 times table. Use BBC Bitesize for multiplying and dividing by 8 <u>activities</u>. Identifying and recognising angles <u>lesson</u>. Use a pencil and a ruler to draw 2D shapes. Count how many angles are inside each shape. Find different coins. How many different ways can you make 33p? 	 Weekly Writing Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day) Continue your journal. What is your favourite activity from this week? What would you really like to do that is not possible at the moment? Spelling activities for this week at twinkl or CEW on this spelling game. Interview a member of your family. It could be someone in your household or over the phone. Write a biography about them. Here are some ideas of questions to get you started. If you could have any fictional character as your best friend, who would you choose and why? What would you do together? Choose your favourite animal. Write a list of instructions of how to look at it correctly. Keep a food diary. Can you describe what each food tastes like?

Learning Project - to be done throughout the week

The project this week aims to provide opportunities for your child to gain a better understanding of plants.

- <u>Music</u> this music is called 'Spirit of the Forest'. Can you make up a dance to go with it including moves to represent trees?
- <u>Art –</u> How to add different textures to your drawings. Collect objects with different textures and patterns. Place a piece of paper over the top and using a pencil carefully rub over the top.
- <u>Design Technology</u> design and build a nest using grass, twigs, leaves etc. Use this <u>link</u> to help.
- <u>Science -</u> check your knowledge on what plants need to <u>survive</u>.
- <u>History Which plants were important to the Egyptians and why? Find out here</u>.
- <u>**Geography**</u> Find out about <u>plants from around the world</u>. Can you find one for each continent?
- **PHSE** Why is a good night sleep important? How much sleep do you need each night? What is the best time to go to bed? Use these <u>resources</u> to help.
