



## Learning Project WEEK 7 – Plants

**Age Range: Year 3**

Weekly RE Tasks (Aim to do one per day)	Weekly Reading Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Read this week's reading in your homework diary. What is the message? How is it relevant to us today?</li> <li>• Write a prayer service for your family.</li> <li>• Watch <a href="#">Faith at Home</a> – Hope.</li> <li>• Complete an <a href="#">activity</a> for 'Maisy Milk'. Pray a decade a day for the week.</li> <li>• Read John 21:1-14: Breakfast by the Sea of Galilee. Which words show that the disciples do not recognise Jesus? Which words and phrases tell us how Jesus made himself known?</li> <li>• Draw pictures of Simon Peter and the disciples. Create captions to show their thoughts and feelings about meeting Jesus again after the resurrection.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ask your child to read a chapter from their home reading book or a book that they have borrowed from the library.</li> <li>• Listen to your child read and let them discuss what they have read. Encourage them to read with expression and intonation.</li> <li>• Watch Newsround and discuss what is happening in the wider world.</li> <li>• Read the instructions to a board game. Can you explain to someone else how to play it?</li> <li>• Watch a TV program or a film with the subtitles and no sound.</li> <li>• Complete an activity in your reading journal as soon as you've finished reading a book.</li> <li>• Complete the Stone Age Cook Book <a href="#">comprehension</a> on Classroom Secrets Kids</li> </ul>
Weekly Maths Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)	Weekly Writing Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Working on <a href="#">Times Table Rockstars</a> your child will have an individual login to access this (20 mins on Studio).</li> <li>• Play on <a href="#">Hit the Button</a> - focus on number bonds, halves, doubles and times tables</li> <li>• Play <a href="#">Solvemoji</a>. How high up the leaderboard can you get?</li> <li>• Keep practising the 8 times table. Use BBC Bitesize for multiplying and dividing by 8 <a href="#">activities</a>.</li> <li>• Identifying and recognising angles <a href="#">lesson</a>. Use a pencil and a ruler to draw 2D shapes. Count how many angles are inside each shape.</li> <li>• Find different coins. How many different ways can you make 33p?</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Continue your journal. What is your favourite activity from this week? What would you really like to do that is not possible at the moment?</li> <li>• Spelling activities for this week at <a href="#">twinkl</a> or CEW on this spelling <a href="#">game</a>.</li> <li>• Interview a member of your family. It could be someone in your household or over the phone. Write a biography about them. <a href="#">Here</a> are some ideas of questions to get you started.</li> <li>• If you could have any fictional character as your best friend, who would you choose and why? What would you do together?</li> <li>• Choose your favourite animal. Write a list of instructions of how to look at it correctly.</li> <li>• Keep a food diary. Can you describe what each food tastes like?</li> </ul>

## Learning Project - to be done throughout the week

The project this week aims to provide opportunities for your child to gain a better understanding of plants.

- **Music –** this [music](#) is called 'Spirit of the Forest'. Can you make up a dance to go with it including moves to represent trees?
- **Art –** How to add different [textures](#) to your drawings. Collect objects with different textures and patterns. Place a piece of paper over the top and using a pencil carefully rub over the top.
- **Design Technology –** design and build a nest using grass, twigs, leaves etc. Use this [link](#) to help.
- **Science -** check your knowledge on what plants need to [survive](#).
- **History –** Which plants were important to the Egyptians and why? Find out [here](#).
- **Geography –** Find out about [plants from around the world](#). Can you find one for each continent?
- **PHSE –** Why is a good night sleep important? How much sleep do you need each night? What is the best time to go to bed? Use these [resources](#) to help.
