

Learning Project WEEK 8 – Rainforests

Weekly RE Tasks (Aim to do one per day)	Weekly Reading Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)
 Read this week's reading in your homework diary. What is the message? How is it relevant to us today? Write a prayer service for your family. Watch Faith at Home – Courage. Look at the Eucharistic prayer. Which parts remind us that Jesus is present in the bread and the wine? List five ways to prepare to receive Holy Communion. Read the story of Pentecost from the Acts of the Aposiles. 	 Ask your child to read a chapter from their home reading book or a book that they have borrowed from the library. Listen to your child read and let them discuss what they have read. Encourage them to read with expression and intonation. Watch Newsround and discuss what is happening in the wider world. Complete an activity in your reading journal as soon as you've finished reading a book. In a book or magazine, find five words that you don't know and look up the definition in a dictionary. Complete the 'Charlie changes into a chicken' activity on BBC Bitesize.
 Weekly Maths Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day) Working on <u>Times Table Rockstars</u> your child will have an individual login to access this (20 mins on Studio). Play on <u>Hit the Button</u> - focus on number bonds, halves, doubles and times tables Play <u>Solvemoji</u>, How high up the leaderboard can you get? Complete the <u>activity</u> on identifying fractions. Use these <u>tricks</u> to help you learn your 8 times table. Find out what <u>perpendicular</u> lines are. Where can you see them in your house? 	 Weekly Writing Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day) Continue your journal. What has change in your life or the country or the world over the last week? Correct the spellings on these worksheets or edit a piece of writing you have done recently. Interview a member of your family. It could be someone in your household or over the phone. Write a biography about them. Here are some ideas of questions to get you started. Research an animal that lives in the rainforest. Write a non-chronological report all about it. Write a list of all the places you would like to visit. What would be the best thing about going there? Write a character description of a villain. Use this lesson to help.

Learning Project - to be done throughout the week

The project this week aims to provide opportunities for your child to gain a better understanding of plants.

- <u>Music</u> listen to the sounds of the <u>rainforest</u>. What can you hear? How do the sounds change? How could you recreate the sounds that you can hear?
- <u>Art –</u> draw a picture of the view from a window in your house focusing on the texture of different objects. You could use the skills you practised last week or follow this lesson.
- <u>Design Technology</u> _____design and make a rainforest scene inside a cardboard box like this one.______



- <u>Science find out how a plant transports water. Use this lesson to help.</u>
- <u>**History**</u> Which explorers discovered the rainforests? Who was the first to travel down the Amazon river?
- <u>Geography</u> find out about rainforest biomes. What types of plants grow there? How have they adapted to the hot, humid climate? This <u>PowerPoint</u> might help you.
- **<u>PHSE</u>** watch this week's <u>Picture News Virtual Assembly</u>. Don't forget your pencil and paper so that you can take part in the activities.
