## Music

#### History

Have a look at the sources containing information about Tutankhamun below. Write what these sources tell you about him and write a question you would want to ask about each source.

### Geography

**'Class Dojo'**: Imagine you are Howard Carter. Write a diary entry about the discovery of King Tutankhamun's tomb. Remember to describe where you where and when as to how you managed to locate the tomb.

#### PHSE
