• <u>Music</u>

• <u>Science</u>

Class Dojo': Over these next two weeks we are going to be learning about tooth decay. What is tooth decay? What causes tooth decay? Egg shells are similar to teeth enamel, what do you think will happen to each boiled egg with shells when placed into water, cola, orange juice and milk? Make a prediction for each liquid and set-up the investigation. Next week we will find out what happens and record the results!

• <u>History</u>

Go on a tour of the <u>Natural History Museum</u> and learn about some of the amazing animals on display. Listen to what David Attenborough has to say about the animals.

Geography

Find out about the Galapagos Islands and the species that live there. Create a brochure (leaflet) for people who visit the islands and what they should know about the various species.
