Weekly RE Tasks (Aim to do one per day)	Weekly Reading Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Remind yourself of the story of 'The Ascension of Jesus into Heaven' by watching a video of the story. How do you think the Ascension of Jesus changed the lives of the Disciples? Write down some ideas in a concept/mind map. Write a letter as a Disciple to a friend to tell them about the Ascension of Jesus: How did you feel during the Ascension? What were you thinking at the time? What was His promise to you? Why did Jesus return to Heaven? Prepare a prayer service with your family about the Ascension of Jesus. Read this week's reading in your homework diary. What is it telling you? How is it relevant to us today? 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Read a chapter your home reading book or a book that you have borrowed from the library. Access one of the free book resources (Oxford Owl/Audible) to read a book of your choice. Find words in the book that contain prefixes and suffixes, note down what the root words mean and what the words mean with the added prefix or suffix. Complete the Year 4 Week 4 English pack, complete one activity each day from the pack. Read and perform the 'Song of the Witches', this could be to your family or a pretend audience. Think about your tone of voice, expression and the actions involved in performing a poem.

Develop your understanding of the Year 4 curriculum by completing one week's worth of mini-maths tasks. Log-on to Kids Classroom Secrets and complete an activity of your choice.
