<p>What does the word “responsibility” mean? Read the Passage from St. Paul (1 Corinthians 12: 12 – 27) about the Church being the body of Christ and everybody having a part to play. this. <i>What does it mean? Does it say that only some people have been called to a special task in the life of the Church? Do you think that following Christ and taking on a responsibility in the Church is something that is easy?</i></p> <p>How can you show that you belong to the Church and what can you do? <a href="#">‘Class Dojo’</a></p> <p>At various times in life we are called upon to make promises. When? God made a promise to Abraham about being a great nation. <i>What promise did God make to Noah? When have we ever made a promise? Are some promises easier to keep than others?</i></p> <p>Promises are made during the Sacrament of Marriage, research promises made during the marriage ceremony in a Catholic Church. <i>What sort of commitment is required from a man and woman getting married?</i></p> <p>Read the <a href="#">prayer of Tobias and Sarah</a> on the eve of their Marriage in the Book of Tobit. <i>What are some of the things they ask God to do for them? ## Learning Project - to be done throughout the week

The project this week aims to provide opportunities for your child to gain a better understanding of the **Key Events in WWII**

Some of these tasks will be set via 'Class Dojo' during the week – please complete them online, as teachers will be able to provide feedback.

- **PHSE ('Class Dojo')** – Complete the some of the friendship activities on the [NSPCC website](#) and share your thoughts on Class Dojo.
- **History ('Class Dojo')** – Complete the World War II activity timeline sheet – this can be found on the class story.

Research one of the key events during World War II: The Battle of Britain, The bombing of Pearl Harbour, The Dambusters Raid or The Normandy Landings, and then present your learning. This could be in the form of a power point, a written report, a poster or information leaflet.

- **Art ('Class Dojo')** – This lesson is linked to your History work. After researching one of the key events create a piece of art work to depict this event.
- **Design Technology ('Class Dojo')** – Operation Chastise was an attack on German dams carried out on 16–17 May 1943 by Royal Air Force No. 617 Squadron, later called the Dam Busters, using a purpose-built " bouncing bomb " developed by Barnes Wallis.

Create your own replica bouncing bomb.

- **Science ('Class Dojo')** – Research 'Pehr Henrik Ling' and create a fact file about him.
