

Learning Project WEEK 14 – World War 2

Age Range: Year 5

Weekly RE Tasks (Aim to do one per day)

Married people play their part in the Family of God and so do other people such as Bishops, Priests, and Deacons. They receive a special Sacrament so that they can play their part in the life of the Church. This is called the Sacrament of Holy Orders.

Research information about people who receive the Sacrament of Holy Orders: Archbishops, Cardinals, Bishops, Priests and Deacons. Create a poster or PowerPoint.

Find out about some of the vestments that the Archbishop has to wear and other important symbols that are used to preach and teach the word of God. These might include; The Mitre, The Crozier, The Pastoral Ring and The Pallium. Make a PowerPoint to share your findings.

Find out about what happens at the ordination of a Priest. Create a storyboard of the ordination ceremony.

Being a Priest today is a vocation, answering a call to follow Christ and serve the Church in a special way. What is meant by a 'vocation'? Create some prayers for vocations to the priesthood.
