

# Learning Project WEEK 3 – The origins of the Olympics (The Greeks)

**Age Range:** Year 5

## Weekly RE Tasks (Aim to do one per day)

## • Complete this **Easter Quiz**

- Research the Easter Triduum. What took place on Maundy Thursday and Good Friday? What happens on Easter Saturday night?
- Create a poster explaining the Easter Triduum.
- The service of light starts with the blessing of new fire. What are some of the qualities of fire? Brainstorm important words (e.g. strong, powerful, bright, etc.)

What might this tell us about the Resurrection of Jesus?

- Write a report on the Resurrection of Jesus from His Mother Mary's point of view.
- Write a prayer asking for help and support during the difficulties people are facing around the world during this difficult time.

## Weekly Reading Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)

- Ask your child to read a chapter from their home reading book or a book that they have borrowed from the library.
- Use your child's home reading journal to complete one activity or a book review on the book they are currently reading or have already read.
- Your child can access free resources on <u>Bug Club/Oxford Owl</u> and read a book that matches their book band (free readers are brown and up). After this, direct your child to review the text and justify their opinion with examples from the text.
- Challenge your child to read something around the house that isn't a book. Can they create clues to explain what they read?
- Read these 5 tales from <u>Greek</u>
   <u>Mythology.</u> Can you describe your favourite animals from these stories?

#### Weekly Maths Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)

- Work on <u>Times Table Rockstars</u>. Ensure you complete at least 2 garages, 1 soundcheck and several studios each time you log in. Can you challenge Mr Turner or Mrs Wright?
- Access White Rose Maths Home Learning. Complete one lesson per day of the 'Summer Term Week 1' unit.
- Develop your understanding across the Year 5 curriculum, by visiting and completing each day's <u>mini-maths</u> <u>tasks</u>. Complete week 16.
- Play the <u>Place Value Puzzle</u> game. How many place value digits can you guess correctly?

## Weekly Writing Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)

- Write a diary entry about your day.
- Spellings complete <u>Activity 1</u> matching spellings and definitions (accounts for each child in Year 5 have been created. Username: 364022 followed by children first name. Password: cat)
- Create your own <u>mythical monster</u>, draw it and write a description using a wide range of vocabulary and descriptive language.
- Listen to <u>The Jabberwocky</u> read by Michael Rosen. Can you draw the Jabberwocky from the description in the poem?
- Write a poem about your mythical creature.

## **Learning Project - to be done throughout the week**

The project this week aims to provide opportunities for your child to gain a better understanding of the Greeks.

- <u>Music</u> Research Greek Byzantine music and share three of your findings with a family member.
- Art Use this video to help you to draw an Amphora (Greek vase).
- **Design Technology** Recreate the <u>Acropolis</u>.
- <u>History</u> Watch this <u>video</u> showing the history of Greece from the 26<sup>th</sup> Century BCE to 2016. Create a poster to explain how BC and AD work on a timeline.
- **Geography** Using this <u>image</u> of the world name and locate as many countries as possible. Can you find Greece?
- <u>Science</u> Can you name the main parts of the Circulatory system in your body?
   This <u>video</u> may help you.
- PHSE What would you take with you if you had to leave your home in five minutes? Discuss with a family member, try to provide valid reasons.
