<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Monday 29th June 2020 is the feast day of St Peter and St Paul. Why do we celebrate these Saints? Can you find out what St Peter and St Paul are each the Patron Saint of? Why do you think they are the Patron Saint of these things? Visit Class Dojo and look at our Class Story page. Download the powerpoint about St Paul and St Peter. Have a read through and make notes about both of these Saints. You can have a go at the memory crossword at the end of the powerpoint as well. Have a look at the map of St Peter's and St Paul's journeys to spread the word of God. Can you identify any of the countries they travelled to? Why do you think this journey was difficult? Choose either St Paul or St Peter to write your own prayer to. Think about what you know about them as a Saint, what you can give thanks for and what you might ask them to help or guide you in. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Visit Epic Books and select a book to read throughout the week. Log your book and review on Class Dojo. Use your home reading journal to complete one activity or a book review on the book you are currently reading or have already read. Read a short story or a part of your book to an 'audience' (this could be members of your family or a pretend audience). Concentrate on the expression in your voice - how are you ensuring your audience enjoys listening? If you can, upload a video of you reading for Class Dojo. Choose a main event from a story you are familiar with. Change the event and re-write the following chapter of the story. Choose a book or short story you are familiar with. Create your own story board of the main events. You could make this into a 'flip book' with pictures to show each part of the story.
