

Learning Project WEEK 6 – Our Community

Age Range: Year 6

Weekly RE Tasks (Aim to do one per day)

What contribution could you make to our Parish community in the future? What have you previously contributed? Create two bullet point lists.

- What is the name of our Parish Priest? What are the main tasks he completes within our community? Create a Parish Priest job description.
- Find out more about our school Church. When was it built? Has it been consecrated? Was there another Church there before this one was built?
- Create an image of the Archbishop and label the key vestments and symbols he is wearing and using.
- Research information about the Archbishop of Birmingham and about the diocese of which he is the Bishop of.

Weekly Reading Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)

- Read a chapter from your home reading book or a book of your own choosing. Make a prediction at the end of your reading as to what will happen next.
- Complete a chosen activity from your home reading journal. Design another activity to add to our journals in the future.
- Choose a poem from https://www.poetrybyheart.org.uk/poet ry-for-children/ and summarise this poem using 'who, what, where, when, why and how'.
- Choose an inference challenge question card to complete from https://www.twinkl.co.uk/resource/t-l-2150-inference-challenge-cards
- Complete an online reading comprehension from https://www.twinkl.co.uk/resources/ks2english/ks2-reading/ks2-readingcomprehension or a ten minute reading task.

Weekly Maths Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)

- This week we will be completing activities from the 'Oak Academy' website. There are 5 days of activities based on 'Missing Angles and Lengths'. Each day includes a pre-quiz, lesson and independent activity. Over the next five days you will need to complete the activities for the following: https://www.thenational.academy/online -classroom/year-6/maths#subjects
 - Day 1 Find the value of missing angles.
 - Compare and classify triangles.
 - Compare and classify quadrilaterals.
 - > Find unknown angles in triangles.
 - Calculate unknown angles in quadrilaterals.
- Working on Times Table Rockstars. If your child works on Numbots in school they can access this with the same login.
- Play on Hit the Button focus on times tables, division facts and squared numbers.

Weekly Writing Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)

- Write a diary entry for the day. What have you done? How have you felt? What are you planning to do with your time tomorrow?

Learning Project - to be done throughout the week

The project this week aims to provide opportunities for your child to gain a better understanding of our community.

- <u>Music -</u> Can you create your own jingle to teach younger children how to cross the roads in our community safely?
- <u>Art Create</u> an image of our school community. How can you fit in all the key parts to our community? Think carefully about how to display this.
- <u>Design Technology</u> Design your own community centre. What would you include? What games/activities/lessons might be available there?
- <u>Science</u> How can you encourage your community to stay healthy and well?
 Create a persuasive poster about a chosen topic e.g. exercising, healthy eating.
- <u>History –</u> Create your own life time-line for you and your community. What are the biggest events that have happened? Remember to add on celebrations such as VE day this year.
- Geography How will you be travelling to secondary school in September.
 Can you create a map for a safe walking/driving/bus route? How long will it take you to get there?
